

ADVERTISING IN THE SCHOOLS

School facilities, staff, and school children shall not be employed in the schools in any manner for advertising or otherwise promoting on school property

any commercial, political, or religious interest, individual, or organization

except as approved by the Superintendent of Schools.

Canvassing, soliciting of funds or selling of any items by any outside agency shall not be permitted on the school premises. School personnel may not participate during school hours or on school grounds in the solicitation of orders.
